Cango Caves - The Cango Caves is a cultural and natural landmark in South Africa. The 20 million year-old Cango Caves system consists of a series of hidden chambers cut deep into a thick limestone rock layer. It is situated in the Swartberg Mountains, 30 kilometres north of Oudtshoorn, in South Africa's Western Cape Province.

The Cango Caves became a popular attraction during the 1800s. Many visitors broke off stalagmites and stalactites and wrote their names on the walls. In response, the then governor of the Cape, Lord Charles Somerset, published the first Caves Regulation in 1820. It was designed to protect an environmental resource and banned the collection of souvenirs. Entrance to the caves cost the equivalent of six dollars, the modern equivalent of about R500. Many of the significant discoveries of the caves were made by the first full-time guide, Johnnie van Wassenaar, who opened many of the side chambers and introduced thousands of people to Cango 1, which remains the only part of the caves open to the public.

Safari Ostrich Farm - During your visit experience the world's largest bird which lays the largest egg, has the most beautiful feathers and eyes that make you want to fall in love and hug them. At Safari you can enjoy riding the birds at your own risk, stand on their eggs, touch the birds and cuddle the chicks all in approximately 1 1/2 hours. Safari Ostrich Farm is in Oudtshoorn, the Ostrich Capitol of the world. Highpoints of the Tractor Safari include feeding the ostriches and holding the eggs. Depending on the time of your visit, you can a visit the Incubator Room where you can see chicks hatching or look through the incubator spy camera. The Farm shop offers a diverse range of high quality ostrich leather products including handbags and belts.

Cango Wildlife Ranch - Cango Wildlife Ranch is situated just 3km outside of the picturesque Karoo town of Oudtshoorn, offering sanctuary to some of the world's most endangered species and a haven to visitors. Cango Wildlife Ranch, is the oldest and largest cheetah contact centre worldwide where you can see and feel a huge variety of animals including Africa's spotted king, the cheetah. From the slithering snake to the majestic lion, you will find all you want here. It is is home to a variety of cats such as lion and jaguar. The thrill of Valley of Ancients and Natural Encounters add a thrill element to learning about crocodiles and making the Cango Wildlife Ranch one of the most interactive, exciting tourist attractions worldwide. The Cango Wildlife Ranch is uniquely designed to comfortably host more than 40 species of animals, giving visitors the opportunity to view and, in some cases, even interact with a variety of endangered animals. At the Cango Wildlife Ranch the well-being and welfare of all our animals is paramount in the promotion of our conservation ethic to you, our valued guest. To achieve these aims we promote the concept of Natural Encounters between you and a number of select ambassador species.

Optional tours (at additional cost) – Robben Island tour, Half Day Cape Wine lands, Zip lining, Sunset Champagne Cruise, Scenic helicopter ride, Cape Side Car tour.

DAY 7 : CAPE TOWN

Proceed for Private Full Day Cape Peninsula (Also known as Cape Point tour) - This full-day Peninsula Tour will take you around the entire Cape peninsula and show you the wonders of Cape Town - from the pristine beaches, to the spectacular sight of Cape Point, where the oceans meet. Your tour starts with a scenic drive along the Atlantic Seaboard. Travel via Sea Point and Camps Bay to the fishing village of Hout Bay for an exhilarating boat trip to Seal Island (weather permitting).

Continue to Cape Point through Chapman's peak (if open), where the romantic notion that this is where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet draws thousands of visitors every year. The Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve is recognized globally for its spectacular beauty, rich biodiversity, animal and bird life, historic lighthouses and shipwrecks. Enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant before moving on to the historic naval base of Simon's Town. This is a village rich in history and character, with its penguin and seal colonies, fishing and bird life, and quaint architecture. Drive back to Cape Town along the coastline passing many seaside towns.

Later Proceed Valley of a Thousand Hills - It is an exciting component of Durban and South Africa's province of KwaZulu-Natal - the Kingdom of the Zulu.

The Valley of 1000 Hills – It is one of those few holiday destinations that has something for everyone. Unspoilt nature, wildlife, magnificent scenery, wining and dining, and warm country hospitality just a half an hour's drive from the centre of Durban. The area is named after the thousands of hills which tumble down to the mighty Umgeni River, which flows from the distant Drakensberg.
