DETAIL ITINERARY

Day 1 London Arrival Overnight : London (England)



Arrival in London's Heathrow airport. Pick up and transfer to the hotel. Check in. Take rest, after lunch we proceed to enjoy the **thames river cruise**. Day 2 London City Tour Overnight : London (England)

Day 3 London City Tour Overnight : London (England)

We travel back towards London. Time at leisure in Oxford street. Drop off at your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 4

Transfer London to Manchester via Oxford Overnight : Manchester (England)



Breakfast at your London hotel. Check out. We then travel towards the city of **Manchester**. En route: We visit the town of Windsor with entrance to **Windsor Castle**. A Royal home and fortress for over 900 years, Windsor Castle, the largest occupied castle in the world, remains a working palace today where the Queen hosts occasional 'dine and sleeps' events for guests, including politicians and public figures. After lunch we walk with our guide through Oxford. Day 5

Day 7 Edinburgh City Tour Overnight : Edinburgh (Scotland)



After breakfast at the hotel, we proceed to the guided tour of the city of Edinburgh which has been the capital of Scotland since the 15th century. Compare Edinburgh's Old Town, to the elegant Georgian New Town with its three main streets and a square at either end. This panoramic Tour's highlights include the Edinburgh Castle, the Palace of Holyrood House, the historic Royal Mile and Our Dynamic Earth.

After enjoying the tour we visit **Edinburgh Castle** which was voted as top U.K. Heritage Attraction and is Scotland's number one tourist attraction. The castle houses the Honours (Crown Jewels) of Scotland, the Stone of Destiny, and the famous 15th century gun Mons Meg, the One O' Clock Gun and the National War Museum of Scotland.

After lunch we visit **Dynamic Earth** which is a five star visitor's attraction in Edinburgh that tells the story of planet Earth, how our Earth works, how life has evolved on its differing environments and the future challenges faced by planet Earth. You'll be embarking on the interactive adventure of a lifetime - the lifetime of our planet. Time at leisure at the **Royal Mile**. The Royal Mile is the name given to a succession of streets forming the main thoroughfare of the **Old Town of the city of Edinburgh**. Its High Street becomes crowded with tourists, entertainers and buskers.

Drop off at your hotel and check-in for an overnight stay.

Day 8 Loch Lomond and a Highland tour Overnight : Edinburgh (Scotland)



After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we proceed for a visit to **Loch Lomond and a Highland tour** – We travel from Edinburgh heading west on the motorway driving past the country side and the towns of **Blackburn** and **Harthill**. Moving ahead on the motorway we cross **Bargeddie** and drive past the famous **city of Glasgow** moving further north crossing into the **Trossachs National Park** to arrive at the **Loch Lomond**. En route photo stop at **Stirling Castle**, one of Scotland's most historically important sites.

Entrance to a local **Whisky Distillery**. Tasting local whiskey brands.

After the Whiskey Distillery visit, we proceed towards **Loch Lomond**. Time at leisure. Loch Lomond is the largest freshwater loch in Scotland and includes 30 islands. A place of outstanding natural beauty, where you can explore the diversity of landscapes that have inspired painters, musicians, artists and writers.

After lunch, we proceed towards the famous and historic city of Glasgow for a guided city tour. For 1400 years Glasgow has been a religious community, a medieval university town and the second largest city of the British Empire, famed for its shipbuilding and engineering. You would discover Scotland's largest and most colourful city by visiting George Square, the Glasgow Cathedral, Glasgow Science Centre, The Tall Ship, Glasgow University, Kelvingrove Art Gallery & Museum, Botanical Gardens..

Following Glasgow's city tour, we travel back towards Edinburgh. Drop off at your hotel for an <mark>ov</mark>ernight stay.
